ORDINANCE NO. 10635

RELATING TO PROCUREMENT; REENACTING TUCSON CODE SECTION 28-48(4) RELATING TO THE SUBMISSION OF SUBCONTRACTOR LISTS; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council reenacted Tucson Code (TC) § 28-48(4) in Ordinance No. 10434 on July 10, 2007;

WHEREAS, TC § 28-48(4) was automatically repealed by Section 2 of that Ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council must reenact TC § 28-48(4) to make it effective;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TUCSON, ARIZONA, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. TC § 28-48 is amended by reenacting TC § 28-48(4) as follows:

“Sec. 28-48 Procurement of Construction.


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Sec. 28-48(4) If failure to comply with subsection 28-48(2) would result in the rejection of the lowest responsive bid, and the next lowest responsive bid is five (5) percent higher (or more) than the lowest responsive bid, the director shall allow the lowest

responsive bidder an additional two (2) days from the time of bid opening to submit the required subcontractor list."

SECTION 2. WHEREAS, it is necessary for the preservation of the peace, health, and safety of the City of Tucson that this ordinance become immediately effective, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be effective immediately upon its passage and adoption.
